

2021 NORTHERN DISTRICT 4-H QUALIFYING CLINIC AND HORSEMANSHIP SKILLS EVALUATION INFORMATION AND RULES

PURPOSE: To allow 4-Hers to qualify for the State 4-H Horse Show in a setting that will provide them with education and information about the divisions in which they wish to participate. Emphasis will be placed on proper tack and attire, suitability of mount, show ring etiquette, rules and specifications of the classes within the division. Participants will also have an opportunity to complete Levels One and Two Horsemanship Skills Evaluation.

Scratches will be filled from the waiting list, and refunds of fees will be made ONLY IF THEIR POSITION IS FILLED. Applicants will be notified of their status

RULES FOR PARTICIPATION:

1. All participants must be bona fide 4-H horse project members. All animals must be their 4-H Project animals, registered with their respective Extension Unit and part of their Horse Project Record.
2. Participants must meet all county and state 4-H regulations for entry to State 4-H Horse Show.
3. Clinic Requirements:
 - Participants must be prompt and be ready to begin clinic at the appointed time.
 - Participants must come to clinic attired and turned out as they would for the State Show. Horses must be groomed and turned out for their appropriate show division.
4. This clinic may be used to qualify horse/rider combinations for the state show.
5. Measurement of horse available on request at clinic.
